

PARISH COUNCIL MEETING  
(Unofficial Minutes)  
May 4, 2017

The May Parish Council Meeting was called to order by Keith Brack at 8:03 pm. There were 9 members present, plus Father John, Judy Gleason, and Tena Gleason. Father John led the council in prayer. The minutes were read by Drew Hubbell; there were corrections to the minutes; a youth group, instead of NCYC, will be headed to the Steubenville Conference in St. Louis on July 14-18. Sonja approved the minutes as read with corrections and Jenny Schmidt seconded.

COMMISSION REPORTS

**Property:** 5 members met. The water softener has been installed. The guttering on the east side of the church is causing problems and leaking water into the church. The underground drainage may be plugged; the committee is looking further into answers to fix it. The elevator inspection is still on hold; Keith is waiting on a call. Fire extinguishers will be checked later this month. The committee is thinking of new members to join.

**Faith Formation:** 4 members met. The next Faith Formation is scheduled for Sunday, May 14, 2017, after 9:30 Mass. Chris Zordel will provide the meat and participants will provide sides and desserts for lunch that day. They will finish discussing *Resisting Happiness*. Discussion was held on new members.

**Church & Community Affairs:** 3 members met. The committee made \$900 on the annual Easter bake sale. The next meeting, June 1<sup>st</sup>, will be the welcoming for new members and a going-away for old members. The committee has scheduled pictures for the parish directory; a sign-up date will be available May 24-26 and June 2-4. More information will be listed in the bulletin. They are thinking of new members as well.
