PANCAKE BREAKFAST:



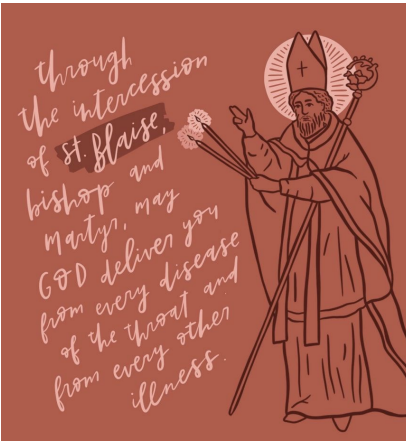
