PARISH ROSARY CHALLENGE:

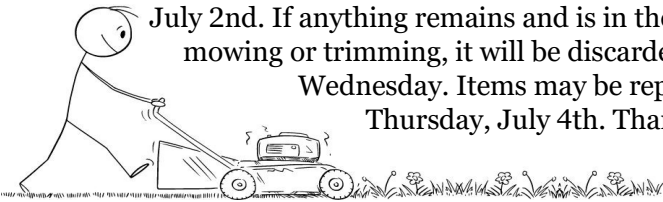
