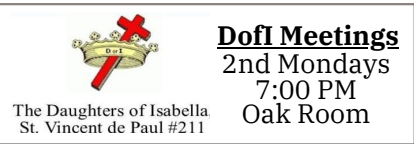
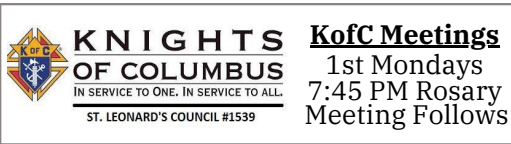

The first reading says "Blessed is the one who trusts the Lord". Do we as stewards trust the Lord in the year of drought, show no distress and still bear fruit?

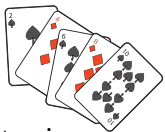

March 14th - Daughters of Isabella

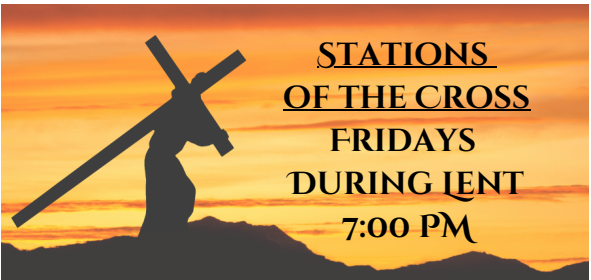
