CEMETERY MOWING NEXT WEEK:

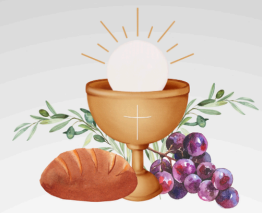
