Sponsored by the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph, St. Joseph Workers serve people in poorer communities who also are still suffering consequences of Hurricane Katrina. The congregation provides successful applicants with room and board and a stipend for personal needs, and it places them for ten months (August – June) in health care, education, advocacy, social services, spirituality or community organizing positions serving diverse communities. Integrating values of justice,

leadership, spirituality, community living and living simply, the St. Joseph Worker program also provides mentoring, spiritual development and leadership training. They created the St. Joseph Worker program two years ago because the need for community rehabilitation following Hurricane Katrina is still so great.
