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RELIGION CLASSES BEGIN WITH BULLYING PROGRAM — On Wed., August 27, St. John Parish will kick off their Religion year with an evening with Mr. Joe Coles. Mr. Coles is from Cimarron and will be spending the evening talking about “Bullying”. He is a well known speaker and does presentations at schools in the area. The program will be presented in three sessions. We will begin at the Parish Center at 6 p.m. with grades K-6. At 7 p.m., he will visit with grades 7-12, and finally at 8 p.m. he will talk to parents and any other interested members of the parish.

Following the 8 p.m. session, there will be refreshments and an opportunity to register for Religion classes and pay enrollment fees.

The opening Mass for Religion will be September 3 at 7 p.m. Please have your children at the classrooms by 6:45 that evening so that they can walk to Mass and sit as a class. Following Mass there will be refreshments at the Parish Center and another opportunity for parents to enroll their children. Enrollment fees for this year are \$10.00 per child.
