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CATECHIST FORMATION FALL: September Sessions "Let Prayer Teach" Presenters: Bishop Emeritus Gilmore and Coleen Stein. The single most important factor in the lives of a catechist and their children and teens is their relationship with God. One name we give that relationship is prayer. Some

communication happens quite naturally, a young child will learn communication skills by watching and listening to others. But other communication skills need to be taught, like reading and writing. The same can be said for prayer. Yet, what we need more than anything else is not textbooks, but text-people. That's what a catechist is. Pope Paul VI called them witnesses.
