One of the greatest reasons to be a Catholic is the opportunity to receive Jesus' Body and Blood at Mass. We genuflect on our right knee towards the Tabernacle to give Jesus the praise and the glory that He deserves. We fast for one hour from food or drink before receiving Holy Communion in order to have nothing physically in us to receive the Bread from Heaven. Each time we receive worthily the Blessed Sacrament our venial sins are wiped away and it preserves us from future mortal sins. We say "Amen", which means "Yes, it is true!", before receiving Jesus to show how we believe in His real presence. Make it a point to visit Jesus at least once a day to increase your faith in Him. He waits for you in the Sacrament of the Altar.
