Since the earliest days of our Catholic Church, it has recognized three forms of penance in the life of the Catholic Christian. These 3 forms are a good measure of how well we are approaching holiness and sanctity. "The three forms, fasting, prayer and almsgiving, which express conversion in relation to oneself, to God, and to others." (CCC 1434) Your typical American fasts from nothing. We are so used to our air-conditioned homes, hot showers, comfortable couches that we forget to mortify ourselves in order to grow in virtue. The devil likes it when we are constantly comfortable. A simple thing you can do is give up dessert a few times a week. Give up meat, gum, coffee, anything that you find yourself attached to. Prayer is obvious that we need to be doing in order to grow in the spiritual life. Silence, honest conversation with God, meditation of Scripture, are all great ways to connect with Christ. Almsgiving is huge for the fact that so many are in need and when we give of ourself we find ourself. 10% is the Biblical model and the more you give the more you receive in this life and the next. Almsgiving also includes your time and talent. Many Churches have 10% of the people doing 100% of the work. Get involved and you will be truly blessed.
