Why can't women be priests? "Only a baptized man validly receives sacred ordination. The Lord Jesus chose men to form the college of the twelve apostles, and the apostles did the same when they chose collaborators to succeed them in their ministry." (CCC 1577) Our Blessed Mother would of been the best candidate to be a priest being free from sin and the Mother of God, but Jesus didn't choose her to be a priest for whatever reason.
