From the Family Formation Commission —

DID YOU KNOW?: Did you know that there are Eastern Rite Catholics and Roman Rite Catholics? Did you know that the Sacraments are administered differently among Eastern Rite and Roman Rite Catholics? The majority of the over 1 Billion Catholics in the world are Roman Catholic, but there are some who are Eastern Rite. Roman Catholics typically administer Baptism to infants, Eucharist around the age of seven, and Confirmation

anywhere from the age of seven to the early teen years. In the Eastern Rite, they have another way. "In the East, this sacrament (Confirmation) is administered immediately after Baptism and is followed by participation in the Eucharist. . . ." (CCC 1318) In other words, a baby could receive Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Although Eastern Rite and Roman Rite Catholics may do things differently, they both are administering valid Sacraments, from validly ordained priests. Regardless of when, where, or how we receive the Sacraments in the Catholic Church, the most important thing is we stay close to the Sacraments instituted by Christ in order that we might be saved.
