110 YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF PARISH: was Oct. 18. Fr. Rene will be using the chalice of Father John B. Disselkamp, at the Oct. 25 - 26 Masses.

Father Disselkamp was born in Herzfeld, Westphalia, Germany, on Aug. 4, 1858. He was ordained to the priesthood on May 12, 1883. On July 1, 1904, he came to Spearville, to establish his namesake parish and remained pastor until September 1912. During his pastorate at Spearville, he was able to oversee the construction of

the first church building, a rectory, a frame school building and the sisters' convent. By the time he left, the number of Catholic families had grown to 250. In 1931, he retired in Spearville.

He was pastor at Olmitz, Leavenworth, Goodland, Kinsley, Belpre, North Ellinwood, Independence and served Windthorst from 1893-1898. At the time of his death, he ranked fourth in years of service among all priests of the diocese. He died in May of 1938, at age 83 and is buried in the local cemetery.
