PETITION TO AMEND THE STATE CONSTITUTION: This past weekend a letter from the bishops of Kansas was read at the Masses asking all the faithful to support a petition drive to amend the State Constitution. An April 2019 ruling by the Kansas Supreme Court cleared the way for an unfettered abortion industry. A constitutional amendment will reverse the court’s highly political ruling by clearly stating that there is not right to unrestricted abortion in Kansas.
