CHRISM MASS: With Bishop Gerald Vincke, our Apostolic Administrator, celebrating Chrism Mass with us, there is a change in the day we will celebrate this year. Chrism Mass will be celebrated at the Cathedral, at 11 a.m., on Tuesday, March 30 [that is Tuesday of Holy Week].
