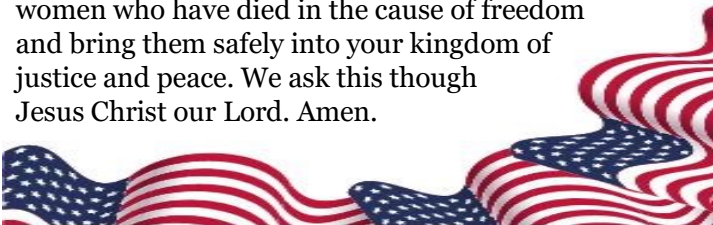
HOW TO CELEBRATE PENTECOST:



Did you know that the Catholic Church considers Pentecost the 2nd greatest feast day following Easter? Pentecost is the Greek word for fiftieth, and comes 50 days after the Resurrection, marking the day in which the Holy Spirit descends in tongues of fire upon Mary and Jesus' disciples. This feast day is also considered the birthday of the church, the day when the apostles were given the gifts necessary to fulfill the Great Commission - to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. We of course celebrate when going to Mass, but celebrate in your homes as well! Wear red to symbolize the flame of the Holy Spirit, bake a birthday cake and light 12 candles, host a bonfire for friends and family! We can enjoy the fruits of the liturgical season in our everyday living.

God of power and mercy, you destroy war and put down earthly pride. Banish violence from our midst and wipe away our tears, that we may all deserve to be called your sons and daughters.
