devote their time to help.

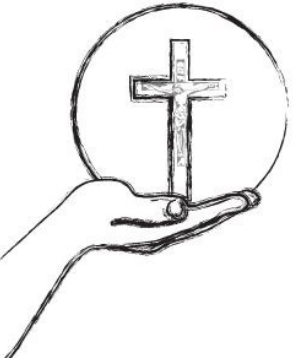


POPE FRANCIS'S PRAYER

information packets on the table in the church entryway.

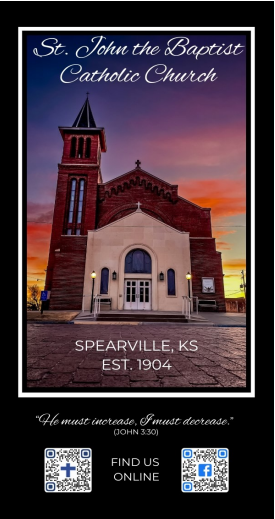
